**POSTER SESSION ANNOUNCEMENT**— In recognition of the increased involvement of undergraduate students in significant research efforts, the Southeast Decision Sciences Institute will once again provide a forum for presentation of this work at its Annual Meeting. Faculty are encouraged to assist their students in being a part of this exciting opportunity to show off the results of their fine work.

A special session of the conference will feature posters representing student undergraduate research at the President's Reception on Thursday evening, March 1, from 6:30-8:00 PM. Students are invited to submit an abstract of their work no later than Wednesday, November 30, 2011, in order to have their posters considered for the conference. Abstracts should now be submitted to the online conference submission system in track PP (Student Posters): <http://www.conferencemgt.com/conf/se12.html>.

Accepted undergraduate projects will be permitted to display a single poster (up to 3 feet by 5 feet in size). If possible, mount on foam core or similar materials. Easels will be provided by SE DSI.

**REGISTRATION FEE**—Undergraduate students whose posters are accepted as part of this special session will attend the President's Reception for free, as guests of SE DSI.

All undergraduate students may also participate in any of the other regular conference sessions by registering for the conference at the Student Registration Fee of \$40.00.

### SUBMISSION PROCESS

The submission process for poster abstracts closes Nov. 30, 2011

1. Interested undergraduate students should submit an abstract of their completed work in PDF format, no later than November 30, 2011.
2. Abstracts must include (1) a detailed description of the research project (up to 1000 words in length); (2) the title of the paper; (3) the name, affiliation, and complete contact information including mailing address, telephone number, and email address of all authors.
3. Accepted students will be notified no later than December 14, 2011.
4. Additional information will be included in the acceptance letters.
